

Rebecca Clearman, MD (her biography)

Dr. Clearman grew up in Michigan and Minnesota and graduated from the University of Texas at Austin and Baylor College of Medicine. She did a medical/surgical internship and her residency in physical medicine and rehabilitation in Houston at the Baylor Affiliated Hospitals. During her years of training, Dr. Clearman did a fellowship in psychiatry. She is board certified in Physical Medicine and Rehabilitation, a specialty focusing on illness or injury from the patient's perspective.

Dr. Clearman has extensive experience in the management of catastrophic illness and is expert in the rehabilitative care of patients with cancer, spinal cord and brain injuries, neurologic diseases, psychiatric illness, burns, polytrauma, and orthopedic injury. During her twenty years in academic medicine, she served as Associate Director of Rehabilitation at MD Anderson Cancer Center, Medical Director of Outpatient Services for TIRR, Vice Chairman of the Department of Physical Medicine and Rehabilitation at the University of Texas Health Science Center at Houston, Medical Director of Hermann Hospital Rehabilitation Program, and Program Director at TIRR Hospital.

She is on the faculties of three medical schools and has received awards and honors from both the medical and lay communities. She is a Fellow of the American Academy of Physical Medicine and Rehabilitation, of the American College of Sports Medicine, and of the Physiatric Association of Spine, Sports and Occupational Rehabilitation.
